MATHEMATICS

Numbers

Numbers to 120:

Read and write number in words and numbers, compare, order, make tens and ones

- Addition and subtraction 2-digit numbers without regrouping
- Double numbers to number 10
- Identify equal and unequal shares

<u>Measures</u>

- Compare lengths (shorter, longer)
- Time to the hour and half an hour

Statistics:

- Represent data with Picture graph, Bar graphs and Tally chart

Geometry:

- Identify 3-D shapes (cylinder, cube, sphere, rectangular prism)
- Identify 2D shapes (square, triangle, rectangle, circle) curved and straight sides

ENGLISH

Test Sections:

- 1. Reading Comprehension
- 2. Vocabulary
- 3. Language Arts/ Mechanics (Grammar & Usage)
- 4. Writing

Reading

- *Read a short passage and identify characters, setting, plot, sequence...
- *Understand main idea and details, problem and solution
- *Retell events in order

Vocabulary

- *Word Groups: Synonyms (happy/glad), Antonyms (hot/cold)
- *Categories: Animals, body parts, furniture, colors
- *Context Clues: Understand meaning of words in simple sentences

Language Mechanics

- *Capitalize proper nouns and sentence beginnings
- *Identify parts of a sentence (subject/predicate)
- *Singular vs. plural nouns

<u>Writing</u>

- *Write short sentences with a topic sentence
- *Use correct capitalization and punctuation
- *Correct sentence structure

Tips for Preparing Students

- *Practice analogies daily (turn them into games!)
- *Use flashcards for roots and affixes
- *Model using context clues while reading aloud
- *Focus writing practice on organizing ideas clearly
- *Provide tiered vocabulary lists by subject (academic vs. everyday use)
- *Emphasize grammar within the writing process, not just in isolation
