5. **YFU** → (Grade 9, 10 and 11)

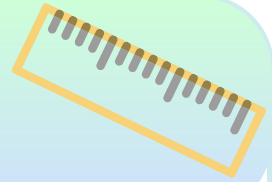

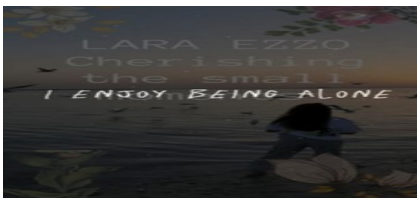

ATTENDANCE
